## 2nd Notices for Annual Dues Sent

The majority of Wiltondale residents have paid their 2007 dues, but there are still about 135 households who have not paid the \$40 Wiltondale Improvement Association fee.

As a reminder, annual dues finance maintenance of common community areas like the Triangle and Greenwood Park, provide financial backing to voiced concerns about local zoning, and fund holiday parties and social events.

One of the WIA's focuses this year was improving the park. More than \$18,000 was spent on improving the drainage system, installing a fence between the tot lot and the parking lot, removing and replacing mulch and landscaping timbers, trimming overgrowth and cutting down the fruit-dropping persimmon tree.
