A reminder... In these winter months it is important to follow county laws regarding snow removal from your property. Baltimore County requires that all snow be removed from sidewalks and stairs to houses and buildings within 24 hours of snowfall. The snow may not be discarded onto any paved area (ie the road), but may be tossed onto your yard. Keeping gutters cleared of snow, ice, and debris such as fallen leaves or tree branches helps prevent flooding and is also the property-owner's responsibility.

Zoning Variance Approved

A zoning variance that Ascension Lutheran Church had sought in order to build an addition on its York Road side has been approved.

By an a order dated Dec. 9, Deputy Zoning Commissioner Thomas H. Bostwick granted the church's request to extend the building to 23 feet from York Road instead of the normally required 35 feet. At a zoning hearing on Oct. 27, church officials said that their proposed addition, because of the nature of the lot, cannot be built within existing setback requirements. Church officials have said that the addition will not expand the size of their congregation or their roster of activities but is being built to modernize their building for existing programs. If final plans are approved by the congregation, construction will begin this spring and will last for up to 16 months.

Many people came to the meeting to hear the presentation by BGE on the power outage issue that has been a recurring problem here. If you missed it, you missed a thorough and informative presentation by five BGE representatives.

If you have a tree in your yard near the power line that is in poor condition, please call BGE and ask that they come out to look at it.

The most important thing we as customers can do is to call BGE when the power goes out. Information from the calls is collected which allows BGE to determine where the problem is. So don't assume that your neighbor is calling, everyone whose power is out needs to call.
