WIA President's Letter

As many of you are aware, several Towson neighborhoods including many close to Wiltondale are plagued by problems with houses rented to college students. While some of these homes may be occupied by responsible renters, too many cause severe quality of life issues for families who live in the affected communities.

Unfortunately this problem won't go away. Towson University's enrollment is expected to grow for several years, outpacing the construction of on-campus housing. This growth will force more students to find off-campus housing, whether in an apartment complex or in rental properties in surrounding neighborhoods. It would be nice to think that the county inspectors could handle this issue themselves, but the problem is just too big.

Wiltondale has been an active supporter of our neighbors who have to fight with the rental property owners in various hearings in Baltimore County. It's important for us to support these communities now so that we can count on them for support when this issue becomes a problem for Wiltondale.

Chris Raborn has been most active on this issue through her involvement with the Greater Towson Council of Community Associations (GTCCA). Given the size of the problem and work involved, Chris can't do it alone. If you are concerned about your community and can spare some time to attend a day-time hearing in Towson on occasion, I encourage you to attend the next board meeting on Tuesday, July 13 at the pool to learn how you can help. The meeting starts at 7:30.
