## Stay Alert to School Bus Riders/Walkers

Stoneleigh Elementary School students are bus riders this year due to the one-year renovation of SES. Please be aware of the significant number of students from our neighborhood who routinely walk to school, but this year are waiting at bus stops. Police will be on the lookout for drivers passing school buses that are stopped to pick up or discharge students. Maryland law states that vehicles must come to a complete stop on both sides of the street if there is no physical divider or barrier. Drivers may not pass the bus until all lights have ceased flashing. Penalties start at \$570 with points charged. Be a responsible driver and stop when a school bus is loading and unloading students!

Please also watch out for those middle school and high school students who walk to school: they don't always pay attention when crossing the street. As always: drive carefully!



# Wiltondale Improvement Association President's Letter

Acorns and leaves on the ground, a hint of morning chill in the air and the appearance of crossing guards and children with backpacks can mean only one thing - summer is winding down. I hope everyone has had a safe and relaxing summer and is ready for school and other fall activities to begin. As always, the uptick in activity brings increased traffic on Wiltondale's streets - please drive carefully.

I would like to take a moment to update you on a few items of neighborhood business. First, as we hopefully enjoy a respite from the emergency tree work we've had to undertake in Greenwood Park this summer, the Board has turned its attention to renovation of the park. We are evaluating several bids and will engage a contractor shortly for work to be done as soon as possible this fall. This work will include new mulch for the playground, tree trimming, new plantings and drainage work on the hillside to deter erosion and water runoff. Watch for this work in the coming weeks. Next, I want to remind everyone that Board meetings are open to all residents, and that approved minutes of past

meetings are available upon request by contacting me or WIA Secretary Anita Richardson using the link on the Wiltondale website. The next WIA Board meeting is Tuesday, Sept. 11 at 7:30 pm at Ascension Lutheran Church. State Senator Jim Brochin will be our guest that evening.

Finally - and reluctantly - I want to briefly discuss rats. Several residents pointed out to me recent articles in the Sun and Towson Times regarding rats in the Towson area. With this in mind, it should be understood that Wiltondale is not immune from rat infestation. There is precedent for activity in our neighborhood, and it is vital that everyone do their part to make this a non-issue in our community. Uncut grass, accumulations of debris, food scraps and standing water all encourage infestation. Please be aware and tend to these items around your house. If you missed these articles, the Baltimore County website has plenty of helpful information on this topic.
