Wiltondale Improvement Association President's Letter

May is upon us, one of the busiest months of the year on the neighborhood calendar. I hope everyone has a chance to get out and enjoy some of the upcoming activities, including Dumpster Day on May 4, the 13th Annual Wiltondale 5k and Fun Run to benefit Greenwood Park on May 11, and the opening of the Pool on Memorial Day weekend.

Many thanks to everyone who came out last Saturday to help at our spring cleanup day at Greenwood Park. The plantings installed last fall are coming in nicely, and with the drainage work that was done on the hillside, the new playground mulch installed in mid-April, and the general sprucing-up we accomplished last Saturday, the park really looks great. It's another reminder of the kind of sustained investment required to keep our neighborhood in top shape. Across all of these projects, we've invested nearly \$18,000 in the park over the last 12 months- not even counting volunteer labor. While we don't spend to that level every year, maintaining a key community asset like the park requires an ongoing commitment. All the more reason to come out and support the race on May 11.

I'd like to provide an update on a couple of important projects that the WIA Board of directors is working on. First, we will deliver an updated directory this year. We're currently working on cleaning up the database, and also making some design and formatting decisions. Later this summer, we will contact you to verify your directory information for accuracy. We estimate that the updated directory will be delivered sometime this fall. The second project, in its early stages, is to plan and deliver an upgraded web capability for Wiltondale. The target date for delivery is still TBD, as we have just started planning. We will evaluate enhancements for e-commerce, general information and communication. We will be balancing many considerations as we approach this project – improved functionality, convenience, security and privacy, maintainability and cost. Stay tuned for further developments, and we welcome your feedback on this effort. As always, I am grateful to the members of the Board for their volunteer work on these projects.

Please keep an eye out for your WIA dues invoice – you should be receiving it soon if you haven't already. Dues are essential to supporting community activities and projects such as those described above. Please write that check today! Finally, congratulations to all of the May graduates in Wiltondale and their families. Enjoy safe celebrations with family and friends as you take this time to reflect on your accomplishments.
