Home Improvements Require Board Approval

The Architecture Committee of the Wiltondale Improvement Association is requiring **45 days** for review of property changes. Please plan ahead. Submission of forms and approval by the committee is **required** for all exterior home improvements. In addition, you are required to review your plans with your immediate neighbors prior to submitting forms. A "Proposed Improvement Review Form" can be downloaded from the Wiltondale website at <u>www.wiltondale.org</u>. To have plans reviewed for approval, contact <u>arch@wiltondale.org</u>.
