Snow's all melted, temperatures are climbing finally as we escape the throws of this past Winter and turn to Spring! As we do folks are getting out all their lawn equipment and yard furniture to maintain their yards and enjoy the warmth of Spring and Summer.

Sadly though this seasonal change also brings out those that prey upon us and I'm not talking bees and mosquitoes! No, I'm talking of those Pests amongst us that desire our stuff without asking and not returning!

Submission of forms and approval by the committee is <u>required</u> for all exterior home improvements. In addition, you are required to review your plans with your immediate neighbors prior to submitting forms.
