In addition, you are required to review your plans with your immediate neighbors prior to submitting forms. ## **WIA PRESIDENT'S LETTER**

It's hard to believe that summer is ending and school is already starting. Time sure flies when you're having fun.

In case you've missed it, there are many new developments in Towson. There is finally an active left hand turn arrow at the traffic light at the intersection of York Road and Cross Campus Drive. Now northbound traffic on York Road can safely turn onto Cross Campus Drive, but be sure to watch out for the new raised brick crosswalk as you proceed up the hill. Towson University has also constructed a new pedestrian bridge over Osler Drive near Towsontown Blvd.

Regarding our public schools, there are renovations planned for Dumbarton Middle School and Towson High School is scheduled to receive a new turf field. There is an evolving elementary school redistricting plan that so far does not impact Wiltondale. However, we will continue to watch this issue closely.

We now have a new movie theater at Towson Square, and there are several additional commercial mixed-use developments in the planning stages, including 101 York Road, Towson Row and the Towson fire station site at the corner of Bosley Avenue and York Road.

There has been spirited debate about the pros and cons of all of these changes in Towson. The Wiltondale Improvement Association Board of Directors will continue to monitor progress on these various developments and provide input where appropriate. We value feedback from our residents on these issues so that we can continue to represent the views of the neighborhood to our

councilman, county executive and the Greater Towson Council of Community Associations (GTCCA.org). Please send your feedback to contact@wiltondale.org.
