Home Improvements Require Board Approval

The Architecture Committee of the Wiltondale Improvement Association is requiring <u>45 days</u> for review of property changes. Please plan ahead. Submission of forms and approval by the committee is <u>required</u> for all exterior home improvements. In addition, you are required to review your plans with your immediate neighbors prior to submitting forms. A "Proposed Improvement Review Form" can be downloaded from the Wiltondale website at www.wiltondale.org. To have plans reviewed for approval, contact arch@wiltondale.org.

USPS Collection Box for Wiltondale

In September, a petition letter was submitted to the USPS along with the more than 100 signatures of Wiltondale residents requesting that a collection box be reinstalled in our community. In November, the manager of our 21286 branch office informed me that our Wiltondale community does not justify reinstallation of a box. Many of us find this explanation unacceptable considering the fact that we are a community of 360 homes and traveling to Stoneleigh or Rodgers Forge for a box is very inconvenient.

In an effort to move this matter to a satisfactory conclusion, a communication was sent to Senator Barbara Mikulski for her assistance. A response was promptly received stating that her office would work with the District Manager of the U.S. Postal Service regarding our request. To date, the matter remains open but there is confidence Senator Mikulski will be successful with our request. We will keep you posted.
