Parking Concerns

Most of the streets in Wiltondale are narrow and parking is allowed on both sides. Normally, this is not a problem and is even desirable, since it narrows the travelled portion of the street and forces motorists to drive more slowly down streets that are often filled with walkers, bikers, and children playing. Recently, however, a fire engine that was responding to a call on Sussex Road found its way impeded by cars that were parked too far from the curb. As a result, the firefighters had to stop their vehicle short of their destination and walk with their heavy equipment to the source of the alarm. Probably as a consequence of this, county police in the next few days ticketed cars in the neighborhood that were parked too far from the curb and that were parked facing in the wrong direction.

Parking in our neighborhood is governed by a state statute that reads:

Parking on two-way roadway

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a vehicle that is stopped or parked on a two-way roadway shall be stopped or parked parallel to the right hand curb or edge of the roadway, with its right hand wheels within 12 inches of that curb or edge of the roadway.

This means, of course, that you have to park your car within one foot of the curb and with the right (passenger) side of your car facing the right-hand curb. In other words, you can't park so as to impede the flow of traffic and you can't park "facing in the wrong direction." Strick adherence to this rule, by residents as well as by their guests, will prevent other emergency vehicles from being blocked and will also prevent those annoying and costly parking tickets.
