WIA President's Letter

Next summer will be the Wiltondale Pool's 60th season, and even though it has been more than 15 years since the last major pool renovation, it remains one of the best features of our neighborhood.

A few years ago, the Wiltondale Improvement Association's Pool Committee began exploring renovation plans to continue this treasured tradition. Through the formation of a Pool Renovation Subcommittee earlier this year, the plans were formalized and the first phase of renovations are currently underway and are anticipated to be completed by the end of this year.

Phase one updates focus on the Main Pool and include: concrete pool deck replacement, new led pool lights, new guard chairs, pool deck drain tile system, re-plaster/whitecoat pool, transition tile and coping repairs, new built-in steps into shallow end of pool, pool perimeter caulking, new diving board, and pool cover modifications.

The Architecture Committee of the Wiltondale Improvement Association is requiring **45 days** for review of property changes. Please plan ahead. Submission of forms and approval by the committee is **required** for all exterior home improvements. In addition, you are required to review your plans with your immediate neighbors prior to submitting forms. A "Proposed Improvement Review Form" can be downloaded from the Wiltondale website at www.wiltondale.org. To have plans reviewed for approval, contact arch@wiltondale.org.
