WIA PRESIDENT'S LETTER

This note is being written during Wiltondale's second snow storm of the winter of 2015-2016. After surviving the Baltimore area's largest snow storm in recorded weather history, the half dozen inches we are now promised almost seems like child play.

This snow cleanup could have been facilitated better, we will endeavor to work closer with County officials and follow up on the private contractors who are paid our hard earned tax dollars to clear passage after such emergencies.

However, the temperament, character and cooperation of our development's community remained as positive as could be under the circumstances. On Monday morning, the first business day after the snowstorm I was able to walk the entire length of Wilton Road's 500 block unencumbered by snow, as substantially every sidewalk was cleared. In fact, portions of the block had three and four foot trenches clearing a walkable path to the number eight bus.

While parking during these snow events we should ascertain emergency vehicles maintain the ability to pass through the streets. Park as close as possible to the curb and where possible not opposite a vehicle from the other side of the street.

Finally, I can't leave this snow discussion before questioning if there is another development in America with Wiltondale's charm after freshly fallen snowfall? I don't think there is!
