Dear Members of the Wiltondale Pool and Wiltondale Community,

Thank you to everyone who provided feedback on the proposed renovations for the pool. We are writing to provide an update on the phase II pool renovation plans for this off-season.

The deadline for submitting comments was **January 15, 2017**. A few themes emerged from the input we received, and we wanted to address these issues in a formal response via this letter. We will be reporting on the feedback and final plans in greater detail at the Wiltondale Annual Meeting on **January 21, 2017**.

- **Guard/check-in station**: Several of you noticed that the illustrations did not include a guard/check-in station. While this was unintentionally left out of the initial rendering, please rest assured that this very important feature is included in the plans on the right-hand side of the new entrance.
- Color/finish: We received feedback regarding the color and finish of the structure and its aesthetic "fit" with the neighborhood. As many of you who have done home renovations know from experience, matching new brick to existing brick is both difficult and costly. However, we are pleased to report that a Wiltondale resident has been able to secure a donation of masonry materials from L&L Supply based out of Towson. The images below provide a sense of what this will allow, and we are truly grateful for the substantial donation.

• **Size/footprint**: The proposed new building is larger than the existing structure because of our need to meet today's restroom codes for capacity and accessibility. We have been operating for many years with insufficient restroom capacity (i.e., too few toilets, sinks and showers), and the Baltimore County Health Department requires that we remedy this with the renovation.





Our goals with the renovation are to modernize the pool, bring us up to code, and contain costs as much as possible. As a reminder, planned improvements include:

- New, modern men's and women's rooms
- Showers in both the men's and women's rooms
- A family bathroom/changing room
- Widened walkways into the pool
- Dedicated entrance/exit gates
- New check-in station
- Additional space for seating under the pavilion
- A retro-fit of the former men's room to create a new office/breakroom

Again, thank you to all who submitted feedback about the renovation plans. We are excited to get this work underway so that we can open on Memorial Day for the 2017 season.

Thank you for your continued membership and support of the Wiltondale Pool, and we will be in touch soon with additional updates.
