Waste Collection Schedule

Trash: Mon., Jan. 9, 16, 23, 30 & Feb. 6 Recycling: Thurs., Jan. 12, 19, 26 & Feb. 2 and 9

Christmas Tree Recycling

Christmas tree collection will take place in Baltimore County from Monday, Jan. 9, to Saturday, Jan. 14. The trees will be chipped and later used as mulch.

Trash and recycling trucks will get the trees as long as ornaments and any other decorations have been removed. No artificial trees will be collected.

Residents should put out live trees along the front curb or street. Do not put trees in alleys, as those will not be collected.

Residents who wish to drop off Christmas trees themselves may do so starting December 26, 2015. Christmas trees (no lights, decorations, tinsel, bags, tree stands, etc.) may be taken to any one of the County's three drop-off locations.



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
