WIA President's Letter

Hello Neighbors,

This is my first letter as President of the WIA, and I thank you for the privilege to serve on the WIA. I want to update you on the motions approved at the annual meeting in January. Thanks to all who took time to participate in the annual meeting, we had a full room and it was a great time to catch up with neighbors.

The attendees at the annual meeting approved three important motions for our community:

- 1) Phase II of the Wiltondale Pool renovations was approved, providing for the construction of a new restroom and shower facility to replace the building damaged last summer by a fallen tree. The new building will include restrooms and shower facilities for men and women, and a family changing room. Construction will begin early next month and finish by mid-May so that the pool can open on schedule.
- 2) A motion to increase the annual dues to \$75 per year effective in 2018 was approved. The increased dues will provide for the maintenance of common areas in the community including the Triangle, Greenwood Park and its parking lot, and continued maintenance of the bridge from the Park to the Towson High School Property. The board recently issued invoices for 2017 dues to each home via email, and by hand to homes for which we do not have an email address. Please kindly remit your dues payment promptly by mailing your check to the address on your invoice.
- 3) The board of Wiltondale Improvement Association was vested to represent the community in zoning matters of interest to community residents. Each year the WIA Board researches relevant zoning issues and provide input on behalf of the community.

The Board continues to seek interested volunteers to coordinate upcoming community events. The next event on the horizon is the visit by the Easter Bunny to the Wiltondale Triangle on April 8. Volunteers will have the benefit of written plans from last year's event and the community has a modest budget to support each event. Please consider donating a bit of your time this year to support one of the events that make Wiltondale such a great place to live.

In conclusion, I would like to thank Ed Watt for his leadership as President of the WIA in 2016. Ed provided a great example to all in stepping forward to volunteer when his neighbor invited him to join the board. We are grateful for Ed's wisdom and good humor.

Our next Board meeting is Tuesday, February 14, 7:30 p.m. in the Luther Room at Ascension Lutheran.
