Wiltondale Resident Steve Prumo briefed the Wiltondale Improvement Association board of directors on this project on March 20. The volunteer project team, called Families for A New Towson High School, is working at the grassroots level to secure funding first to develop a plan for a new high school, and second to implement the plan by building a new high school by 2022.
